ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT: An enrollment deposit will be paid on the registration of all students to guarantee a place for the student when school begins. The enrollment deposit covers one of the monthly payments. If this contract is canceled, the enrollment deposit & insurance fee are non-refundable. This includes, but is not limited to acceptance in UPK, UPK-3 and/or any other program. **There are no refunds or make-up days due to absence, illness, snow days weather-related closures, vacations/school holidays or due to quarantining (also applicable to extended hours). Enrollment deposit must reflect schedule increases. There will be no deposit credits for a decrease in schedules after registration.**

Tuition: Tuition is a yearly fee, payable all at once or divided into 10 equal payments. The first payment is due upon registration which is your deposit. Payments 2-10 will begin September 1 and be due the first of each consecutive month until May. Tuition payments secure a spot for your child and is not based on attendance. Tuition is due on the 1st of each month. Bright Star retains the right to terminate your contract and give up your spot for the school year and/or summer program if payment is not made by the due date. Payments are made from September through May and the enrollment deposit covers one of the 10 payments, so there is no payment due in June. A \$20 late charge will be added for all late payments. A \$30 fee will be charged for all returned checks. A \$100 clerical fee will be charged for schedule changes after registration. This charge is not applicable for schedule increases. The \$100 Fee will be charged each 1/2 hour for any child picked up after 6 p.m. Additional hours other than scheduled will be billed upon the school's discretion. **School will close earlier than 6 p.m. if registration is not sufficient.**

DISMISSAL POLICY: If, in the judgment of the professional staff, the student is unable to adjust to the school program and is therefore dismissed from the pre-school, the tuition will be refunded on a prorated basis. A \$100 clerical fee will be deducted from the refund.

SOCIAL MEDIA: I understand that photos of my child may be taken. I give permission for these photos to be displayed, published, displayed on our website, and on our social media platforms.

SCHOOL TRIPS: I give permission for my child to go on all class trips. The parent assumes full responsibility for the child to and from BRIGHT STAR ACADEMY.

DISCLOSURE: If your child has any special needs, such as; Health, Physical, Emotional, Allergies, etc., the school must be notified upon registration. Any services they are receiving privately or publicly such as early intervention or CPSE must be disclosed. If families do not disclose this information at the time of registration, Bright Star Academy has the right to dismiss the child. All children attending school must have required immunization and medical by the start of school. Bright Star School has the right to dismiss a child for failure of having required medical & immunizations. Bright Star Academy has the right to refuse admittance and/or re-admittance into school for failure to comply with Bright Star Academy regulations/policies. Bright Star has the right to modify their policies to comply with state and local agencies.

INFORMATION PROVIDED: I have provided information on my child's special needs (Allergies, Diet, Disabilities and/or medical information) to Bright Star as may be necessary to assist the facility in properly caring for my child in case of an emergency. In addition, all allergy/disability paperwork must be filled out in its entirety prior to a child attending school.
